You are hereby notified that I have amended Certificate of Approval No. 4152-84KLK5 issued on May 28, 2010 for operation of one (1) pilot grate system, as follows:

The following description has been added to the Certificate of Approval (Air) number 4152-84KLK5 dated May 28, 2010:

"- Modification to the operation of the pilot grate system, to include sand, pea gravel, metal scrap cut-offs and heavy gauge wire as feedstock, and pelletized wood, charcoal briquettes, granular carbon and low-sulphur anthracite coal as supplemental fuel, at controlled feed quantities to the pilot grate system;"

all in accordance with the Application for Approval (Air & Noise), dated December 28, 2010 and signed by John O'Sullivan, PLASCO Trail Road Inc., and all supporting information associated with the application.

All terms and conditions in the Certificate of Approval (Air) number 4152-84KLK5 dated May 28, 2010 remain unchanged.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Certificate of Approval No. 4152-84KLK5 dated May 28, 2010.

In accordance with Section 139 of the Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E-19, as amended, you may by written notice served upon me and the Environmental Review Tribunal within 15 days after receipt of this Notice, require a hearing by the Tribunal. Section 142 of the Environmental Protection Act, provides that the Notice requiring the hearing shall state:

1. The portions of the approval or each term or condition in the approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
2. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

The Notice should also include:

3. The name of the appellant;
4. The address of the appellant;
5. The Certificate of Approval number;
6. The date of the Certificate of Approval;
7. The name of the Director;
8. The municipality within which the works are located;

And the Notice should be signed and dated by the appellant.
