



Notice of Commencement

Plasco Energy Group Inc. (Plasco) is seeking approval from the Ontario Ministry of the Environment to re-permit its Trail Road municipal solid waste conversion facility, currently regulated under Ontario Regulations 253/06 and 254/06, to a permanent permit under the Ministry's Waste Management Projects, Regulation 101/07. The facility is located at the City of Ottawa's closed Nepean Landfill site located at 4420 Trail Road in Ottawa, Ontario and has been converting Ottawa's municipal solid waste since January 2008.

The proposed project is subject to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment's Environmental Screening Process for Waste Management Projects, Regulation 101/07, as set out in the Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Waste Management Projects dated March 15, 2007. The proposed permit would enable the Trail Road facility to continue to convert municipal solid waste into electricity and other valuable products such as construction aggregate and water as a commercial demonstration and development facility.

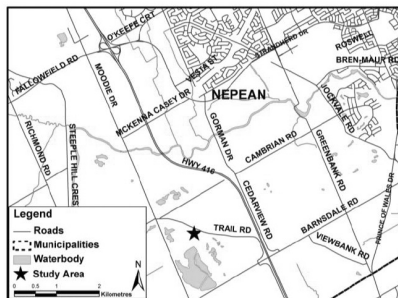
The Environmental Screening process will assess the potential effects of the facility's continuing operation on the natural and socio-economic environment during its operation and decommissioning. Continued consultation with the public, Aboriginal Communities and regulatory agencies will be an integral component of the Environmental Screening process.
