

Notice of Completion

Plasco Energy Group Inc. (Plasco) has completed the Environmental Screening Report (ESR) for the Plasco Trail Road (PTR) Conversion Facility.

Plasco Energy Group Inc. (Plasco) is continuing its work to re-permit its PTR municipal solid waste conversion facility, currently regulated under Ontario Regulations 253/06 and 254/06, to a permanent permit under the Ministry's Waste Management Projects, Regulation 101/07. The facility is located at the City of Ottawa's closed Nepean Landfill site located at 4420 Trail Road in Ottawa, Ontario and has been converting Ottawa's municipal solid waste since January 2008.

The proposed project is subject to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment's Environmental Screening Process for Waste Management Projects, Regulation 101/07, as set out in the Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Waste Management Projects dated March 15, 2007. The proposed permits would enable the Trail Road facility to continue to convert municipal solid waste into electricity and other valuable products such as construction aggregate and water as a permanent commercial demonstration and development facility.

The results of the studies undertaken for the project indicate that PTR will not have significant net environmental effects during operation. Plasco intends to proceed with the permanent operation of PTR as a commercial demonstration and development facility subject to mitigation, impact management measures and obtaining the necessary approvals.

This notice is to advise the public and all other stakeholders that the ESR for PTR will be available for a 60-day review and comment period from June 30 to August 29, 2011. If the parties are unable to resolve the matter, a written request may be sent to the Director of the Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch, Ministry of the Environment at the address below, to elevate the project to an individual Environmental Assessment under the Environmental Assessment Act. All elevation requests must be made in accordance with the provisions set out in Section B.3 of the Ministry of the Environment's Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Waste Management Projects. A copy of the elevation request must be sent to Plasco.

Please note that all elevation requests are considered comments to a public process and information contained in a request will be shared with the proponent and may be circulated to other stakeholders. The last date for the receipt of request for elevation is August 29, 2011.
